He has more than 200 publications including book chapters, editorials, leading articles, review articles, original articles, etc.

In his very illuminating and interesting talk, Dr. Vinay K Kapoor, stressed on how to communicate your ideas effectively, how to capture an audience's attention and how to make it understandable. He hoped that faculty members and students would not only learn to address to communication with other scientists and researchers but also that they will hopefully communicate more effectively science in general or their specific research to a wider audience. This wider audience may include the general public or those from nonscientific backgrounds.
